The wine maker Marc Serguier is the 6 <sup>th</sup> generation of a 30 hectare estate on a plateau overlooking the Rhone Valley across the river from Châteauneuf du Pape enjoying the same terrain and outlook. All grapes are hand picked. Respect for nature and new technology are merged beautifully to produce very fine wines.

Domaine la Millière has 14 hectares of vines in the Châteauneuf du Pape appellation for red wine. Located in the Cabrières sector the terroir is rocks with clay, sand, pebbles and limestone soils. All vineyard management is done using only 100% organic farming techniques. The vines range from 80 to 100 years old. Domaine Milliere also owns 8 hectares of vines in the Cotes du Rhone appellation nearby.

<b>Chateau Mourgues du Grès (Southern Rhône/Costières de Nîmes – François Collard )</b>		
<p>'One of the most impressive estates in the Costières de Nîmes; a treasure-trove of value-priced wines...' <b>Robert Parker</b></p> <p>The vineyards are located near the Mediterranean on the plateau of Beaucaire with the Rhône River nearby. The vineyards are covered with <i>galets</i>, the same round flat stones that are famous in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Meticulous care and attention are paid to the vineyards. Overall management, including crop thinning and pruning, are all carried out by hand. Organic fertilizers are used and treatments are kept to a minimum. The vineyards have been certified organic since the 2011 vintage.</p>

“Beyond my deep respect for the vineyards and wines of Burgundy, I never forget that this divine beverage is meant to share moments of friendship.” Thibaut Marion The drive for high quality can be seen from the vineyards to the wine bottling. There is respect for the environment, terroirs and wine in each step of the production. In the vineyards : organic growing, no use of chemicals, ploughing the soil, reducing the yields thanks to strict pruning and green harvest, hand picking in small cases. In the winery : sorting grapes on a table, natural fermentation in oak, temperature control, maturation in oak, bottling without filtration at the best time for the wine.

<b>Château Crusquet de Lagarcie AOC Blaye Côtes de Bordeaux</b>		
Benoit de Lagarcie is the winemaker on this 4 hectare vineyard situated on the right bank of the Gironde estuary north of Pomerol & St Emilion. The soil is clay over limestone.

<b>Château Calvimont AOC Cérons</b>		
The village of Cérons lies just north of Barsac and was awarded its own appellation in 1936, 10 days before Sauternes was similarly recognised. Cérons was long part of Sauternes until being expelled in 1921 to allow the absorption of the commune of Fargues into Sauternes. Current owners Xavier and Caroline Perromat, devote five of their total of 26ha to this almost forgotten appellation. The plots for the sweet wine are made up of gravel with sand and small stones resting on a limestone bedrock. The microclimate caused by the proximity of the Céron river allows the same development of botrytis cinerea (noble rot) as in the Sauternais. Several pickings during the vintage send only botrytised grapes to be pressed gently in a gravity-fed winery and aged in oak for 18 months.
